Sample Vows:

- (A) In the presence of God and this community, I, name, take you, name, to be my wife/husband; to have and to hold from this day forward, in joy and in sorrow, in plenty and in want, in sickness and in health, to love and to cherish, as long as we both shall live. This is my solemn vow.
- (B) I take you, name, to be my *wife/husband* from this day forward, to join with you and share all that is to come, and I promise to be faithful to you until death parts us.
- (C) I, name, give myself to you, name. By the grace of God, I promise to support and care for you. In the love of Christ, I promise to love and cherish you. With the Spirit's help, I promise to be faithful to you, as long as we both shall live.
- (D) I take you, name, to be my *wife/husband*, and these things I promise you: I will be faithful to you and honest with you; I will respect, trust, help, and care for you; I will forgive you as we have been forgiven; and I will share my life with you, through the best and the worst of all that is to come, until death parts us.
- (E) In the presence of God, our family and friends, I offer you my solemn vow to be your faithful partner in sickness and in health, in good times and in bad, and in joy as well as in sorrow. I promise to love you unconditionally, to support you in your goals, to honour and respect you, to laugh with you and cry with you, and to cherish you for as long as we both shall live.
- (F) I take you (name) to be my wife/husband from this day forward, to join with you and share all that is to come, and I promise to be faithful to you until death us do part.
- (G) I, Name, take you Name, to be my husband / wife, my constant friend, my faithful partner and my love from this day forward.

Exchange of Rings:

- (A) Name, I give you this ring as a sign of my love and faithfulness.

Alternate Exchange of Rings:

- (B) Name, I give you this ring as a symbol of my vow. With all that I am, and all that I have, I honour you, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

RESPONSIBILITIES of BRIDE & GROOM

1. Purchase Marriage License (from any City Hall in Ontario) within three months of the wedding date and no later than three weeks before.
2. Submitting the license to the church office as soon as available.
3. Preparation of ceremony bulletin (worship guide).
4. Purchase & placement of flowers and removal afterwards.
5. Purchase & placement of candles for any candle ceremony/ritual during ceremony and removal of candles afterwards.
6. Decorations (pew bows, decorative pen, etc.) and removal afterwards.
7. Payment of honorarium/fee to pastor, organist, soloist, caretaker on or before rehearsal time.
8. Arrangements with organist, soloist(s) and other musicians.
