Sunday Nov. 26th. This is new frontier for all of us so let's recap the proceedings.

We have, up to now, held an annual Congregational meeting where we would review and approve the previous year's budget, financial statements and dispersal of funds. New council members would then be elected as well. Reports of the Pastor, Chair, Music director as well as other ministries were reviewed and accepted. In the past we have been able to prepare reports and financial reviews for the FEBRUARY annual meeting. Today, however, an accounting firm needs to be engaged to do these reviews. this has required us to push our FINANCE REVIEWS AND APPROVAL to June of each year.

We now have a budget meeting in November (as just passed) and choosing of new council members. June 2024 will now be our ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING to address all matters not pertinent to budget. The previous year's financial statements will then be approved.

The reports on our Ministry will cover the same calendar year we have always used and still due in January of the new year.

We hope this answers some of your questions about these changes.
