Congregational Meeting - Sunday 24th September.

We introduced the **Congregational Survey**. This will be used to show what the important things

are for you at Trinity and our ministry work here. The details of what individuals say in the survey will be not be identified, but rather the "Facing the Future" team will using a summerization of the survey data to guide the direction of our different options for the next few years.

Also, at the congregational meeting, we **passed some motions** relating to our financial reporting. The constitutional motions require a 2nd reading in order to be changed. That will happened at the next congregational meeting in November. We also approved the by-law change to hold two regular congregational meetings – a budget meeting in November each year, and a review meeting in June.

At the November meeting, we also hope to give you an update on the work of the "Facing the Future" group including some feed back from the survey results.
