11th ANNIVERSARY OF THE YAMAHA 9' CONCERT GRAND PIANO

At 9 feet long, this is the largest piano in any London church and we became the 3rd owner since its manufacture in the late 1970s. A church in St. Thomas was moving to use only praise band music for their worship. The piano had been in storage for a few years. We held the dedication of this beautiful piano on 10th April 2013. Check the website for the video.

It is a top quality CONCERT piano and is sought after by the Kiwanis Music Festival and this year is being used for the Young-Ja Park Memorial Piano Competition on 25th April. Over the past 11 years we have had around 1000 piano players at various levels compete on those 88 keys. Today Nancy and I will be playing, MEDITATION from THAIS by Jules Massenet, NESSUN DORMA from TURANDOT by Giacomo Puccini and EIGHTEENTH VARIATION from RAPSODIE ON A THEME OF PAGANINI, Opus 43 by Sergie Rachmaninoff.

22nd ANNIVERSARY - 3RD ITERATION - CASAVANT PIPE ORGAN

The first Casavant organ was replaced by a much larger 2 manual Casavant. In 2002 the organ was upgraded with a fuller console (the one you can see now) to include three 61-key manuals as well as a digital system to allow for synthesised sound generation. The 2 manual console is still in operation up in the balcony. Today we are also marking and recognizing that 3rd iteration anniversary.

For this 3rd iteration, Hugh Drogemuller booked the renowned concert organist Dr. Thomas Murray from Yale University USA to play the Inaugural Organ Concert, Friday January 26, 2001. He played a concert of classical and transcription genres of music. Hugh knew me through London Centre of the London Royal Canadian College of Organists and asked me to play a second Organ Concert April 27th, 2002. I played a transcription and theatre organ type program of music from stage and silver screen.

These two concerts were to show the “second to none” versatility of this organ that can play all genres of music, from Lutheran Liturgical, Traditional, Gospel, Contemporary, to Concert Classical, Transcription, Theater Organ and everything else in-between types of music. Hugh had this organ designed with all the resources including MIDI (digital stuff) to never become obsolete. The results are spectacular. Later that year, I became the Director of Music at Trinity in September 2002 and get to play these wonderful instruments every week. They are a joy to hear and a delight to play.

The organ and piano are not only fine instruments for our congregation, but for our city of London and our province of Ontario. They have provided, and will continue to provide, wonderful musical opportunities and experiences. They have been a blessing to all who hear them.

We pray that God will bless the music made from these instruments in this church, bless the musicians who create the music and use it to his glory.
