Trinity is part of the North/Centre group of churches that takes turns hosting. This year the service was written by Christian women from Nigeria. Please come and participate in this meaningful service and support the work of WICC(Women's Inter-church Council of CANADA) who coordinate and distribute materials for this service. WICC is a grassroots prayer movement that supports women and children with small grants. For example, in Ontario a grant of \$1000 was given to Elora House for a project that builds hope and healing for trafficking survivors. In British Columbia an organization called A Way Home Kamloops Society received \$5000 to support young women's housing. Internationally, small grants that can help to do big things were given to groups in Angola, Kenya, Guatemala among others.
